Feast of Saint George 2017: This year Saint George's Day (April 23rd) falls on a Sunday - the Second Sunday of Easter. Community Sponsorship of Refugees: An application to the Home Office is being prepared in conjunction with Churches Together in Warminster to host a family under the Syrian Resettlement Programme. The sum of £9,000 approx. is the target to be raised for the purposes of sponsorship and to be available for use if necessary.
