Year of Prayer: Today's Gospel does not make for comfortable reading. For many of us Jesus is the 'Prince of Peace' not someone who wishes to bring conflict into people's lives. Permanent Deacons: One of the first Permanent Deacons in our Diocese, Deacon Wallis Hardy, was ordained at St George's on Whit Sunday 1976 and served in the parish for six years until he retired in his eightieth year. The Permanent Diaconate is open to either single men over 35 who feel called to the celibate life or to married men over 40. Those who are married must have the support of their wife and family. Any candidate must demonstrate the necessary maturity and stability for this life-long commitment. They will be prepared to embark on a four year part-time course of formation. Most candidates will be in the world of work and continue to be so after ordination. Indeed it is the role of the Permanent Deacon to have "one foot in the sanctuary and the other in the workplace". Above all, they will be men of faith and prayer, with a desire to serve others for the sake of God's kingdom.
