**Lampedusa Cross:** Francisco Tuccio is a carpenter from the small Italian island of Lampedusa. When hundreds of refugees who were fleeing Eritrea and Somalia drowned off the coast of Lampedusa he was moved to gather the driftwood from the wrecked boats and turn them into crosses which he offered to survivors as a small but powerful symbol of hope.

Inspired by his actions CAFOD has sent one of his Lampedusa crosses to our parish to help us to reflect on the refugee crisis and on what we can do to help.
