Year of Prayer In this in-between time from Ascension to Pentecost the liturgy of the 7th Sunday of Easter invites us to return to Jesus and join with him in his prayer, a prayer which looks to the future. There is a strong emphasis on unity, on all being one. In our fractured world of today, never do we need this prayer more. We do not need to look far to see many examples of disunity, disharmony and a general mistrust in our communities. Jesus describes his hope, his vision, and his picture of what we, his followers, are to look like and how we are to live our lives together. It is a prayer for community. Jesus prays that "all may be one." To be a follower of Jesus is to be a part of a greater whole. In that 'oneness' we are to be a sign to the world of God's love for us in Jesus Christ. As we move towards Pentecost, let our prayer be for an end to disunity, that we may embrace harmony and live more faithfully the call to live as one in Jesus.
