**Boiler Replacement:** The central heating boiler in the parish Hall has been malfunctioning for some months and despite the replacement of some parts is deemed to have reached its senectitude. It was installed in 2005—12 years is a boiler's average lifespan. The cost of supply and installation of a Vaillant gas fired condensing combination boiler is £3,060 (including powerflush to remove sludge from the system). Donations towards this outlay would be greatly appreciated.
