Ministers of Holy Communion: This year's Family Day (July 1st) offers a stream of formation for those who exercise a Ministry of Holy Communion with our community. The day begins at 10.15am and concludes with Mass at 4pm.

Lampedusa Cross: Francisco Tuccio is a carpenter from the small Italian island of Lampedusa. When hundreds of refugees who were fleeing Eritrea and Somalia drowned off the coast of Lampedusa he was moved to gather the driftwood from the wrecked boats and turn them into crosses which he offered to survivors as a small but powerful symbol of hope.

Pope Francis carried one of the Lampedusa crosses at a memorial Mass to commemorate people who have died and the British Museum is now displaying a Lampedusa cross as a reminder to people of the refugee crisis the world is facing.

Inspired by Francesco Tuccio's actions CAFOD has sent one of his Lampedusa crosses to every cathedral in England and Wales inviting them to display it. We've also shared crosses with schools and parishes where they can be used by Catholics to reflect on the refugee crisis and what we can do to help.
