Year of Mission: Have you picked up on that theme of *Covenant* this year through our Lenten journey? From Noah to Abraham and now with Moses and the People of Israel on Mount Sinai, God reaches out to his people in a desire to come close to them and draw them into his love. The Commandments were to shape the way *God's* people lived their lives. This was the way of living that marked them out as God's people and as distinct from other nations. And these are God's words, not the words of Moses. It is God who speaks relationship to his people and we come to the understanding that it is God who inscribes these *words* on the two tablets of stone... and maybe it is important that we hold that image of stone and the covenant in our minds for a week or two until we come to Jeremiah! God seeks to inscribe his love within us for God seeks to come close to us this Lent because he loves us. As God shaped the People of Israel to become his people so he shapes and fashions us in Lent to radiate more perfectly his image and likeness. We grow in his likeness when we live as he calls us to live – in love with him and living in love of our neighbour, too.
