**Year of Prayer** Our Gospel this Sunday invites us to reflect on two important matters of faith. The first is our capacity to recognise the presence of Christ in our lives, even when we don't see him. Secondly, we are invited to respond to the question asked of Peter: 'Do you love me?' What answer would we give to this?
