CARDINAL NEWMAN CANONISATION Sunday 13th , St Peter's Square, Rome.

John Henry Newman will be the first English Confessor to be canonised since 1457.

As an Anglican clergyman, Newman started reading the early Church Fathers, those Christian writers in the centuries immediately following the Apostles. In them he discovered the richness of Catholic doctrines which started his journey towards the Catholic Church.

Many people know that John Henry Newman was a great thinker, that he was a magnificent convert to the Catholic faith, and that he was a man of great personal kindness. These are the attributes that make him worthy to be a saint.
