Church Roof Leaks: The recent driving rain has highlighted a problem with our church roof with rainwater dropping on the benches to left and right immediately beyond the open area of wheelchair and accessible seating. In 1938 the transept roof structure was joined to the lower nave roof and ever since there have been problems. A roof survey suggests that the lead in the roof valleys appear not to have a water check. The remedial specification of works is priced near £4,000. Fundraising will be needed to meet these costs.
