Year of Communion C.S. Lewis once said, '*Do the right thing even when no one is watching. It's called integrity!*' The importance of living a life of integrity is central to our liturgy today. Being a Christian is not simply following the letter of the law. It is about going above and beyond the law to love. Love is more than just doing the bare minimum. It is not enough merely to follow the law by our actions; we need to let the Lord write the law on our hearts, that spiritual core where our intellect and will combine. When we do we enter into solidarity with one another and harmony with God, who loves us and provides the law for that purpose.

Dowry Tour of Our Lady of Walsingham: This year marks the start of 'Behold, Your Mother' when the people of England are being invited to dedicate themselves to Mary, Mother of Jesus, in 2020.

Clifton Cathedral will be hosting a Triduum of prayer from 20-22 February when they will receive the statue of Mary from the Slipper Chapel at the Catholic National Shrine in Walsingham as part of the preparation for the year of dedication.

In addition, parishes, schools and other institutions are being encouraged to get involved in a variety of ways. One way involves participating in 33 days of simple prayer commencing on 21 February and finishing on 25 March.
