Ash Wednesday: The Season of lent begins on Wednesday which is a day of Fast and Abstinence. Fasting is observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
