**Year of Communion:** In the parable of the two sons Jesus asks us to think whether our words and actions are in agreement. It is easy to talk, to pronounce and to make statements. It is more difficult to give time, effort and attention. Every Sunday we profess our faith, a faith which through our Baptism we are commissioned to live out in the daily activities of our lives. It is easy for us to say the words of the Creed, but it will be by our actions that will demonstrate our commitment to working for the reign of God during the week. Jesus values a few small acts more than many fine words.

**RICE CHALLENGE for BORDERLANDS:** Since the beginning of the lockdown St George's has been supporting the Borderlands charity based at St Nicholas of Tolentino parish in Bristol. The large drop-off in food donations has been causing difficulties in providing for the welfare of the refugees and asylum-seekers supported by the charity. In response a number of rice deliveries to the value of £900 has been donated from this parish to help Borderlands in providing for the hungry in Bristol. **ORDINATION TO THE PRIESTHOOD—THOMAS LAWES:** On Saturday 26th September at 11am in the Cathedral, Thomas Lawes was ordained to the Priesthood to serve in our Diocese. The Lawes family lived in Warminster some years past and attended St George's. Please continue to pray for all our Seminarians in formation for priestly ministry and the work of our Seminaries.

**Starting School?:** If you have a child born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017, now is the time to apply for a place at a primary school for admission from September 2021. You must complete an application form from the school admissions team of Wiltshire Council. If your child has been baptised and you are applying for St George's School you must also provide a baptism certificate to the school. Closing date 15 January 2021.

**COVID:** All entering the Church must now wear a face covering unless they are medically exempt. This ensures the safety of all in an enclosed public space. Priests celebrating Mass, 2m or more from the congregation do not need to wear a face covering except when distributing Holy Communion. Please wear your mask as you approach for Holy Communion, unloop your mask to receive communion and then replace your mask a few paces to the right before returning to your seat. . If you arrive without a facemask there are some available at the Narthex. A donation of £1 may be placed in the CAFOD box by the main door. When Mass is ended please leave immediately by the exit door, guided by the stewards and do not stay in Church to hold any conversations. Thank you for helping to keep a safe environment
