Year of Communion: When we are hurt or angry, we can use silence both as a shield and a weapon. Afraid to say the wrong thing, afraid of causing more hurt, we can sit and fester. But silence is the enemy of peace. Jesus reminds us of the need to seek reconciliation. It is often difficult to take that first step, to be the one to start the conversation especially if we are the wronged one; but in a spirit of generosity and willingness to listen to the other, the process of healing can begin. If, on the other hand we continue to meet with hostility, we are encouraged to seek the help of others to try and bring about peace. Without this peace and reconciliation, the situation will remain bound. In other words we have to do everything we can to resolve the problem. Perhaps in our own life we have a situation which is causing pain either for ourselves or another. Do we need to take that step? Let us ask God for the courage and the willingness to reach out and begin the process.
