NARTHEX ROOF REPAIR: After a number of attempts with minor repairs to halt rainwater ingress it was decided by the Parish Finance Committee to approve outlay of £1,800 to replace the felt membrane with a Firestone RubberCover membrane and install new Lead Flashing and sealant at the joint with the gable wall. The works were carried out in September

Further works have been approved for the sanctuary gable end costing £2,250. We are grateful for donations received to date.
